NEW YORK STATE STANDARDS FOR THE ARTS

I. Students will actively engage in creating works of art that explore different kinds of subject matter, topics, themes, and metaphors. Students will understand and use sensory elements, organizational principles, and expressive images to communicate their own ideas in works of art.

II. Students will know and use a variety of visual art materials, techniques, and processes.
